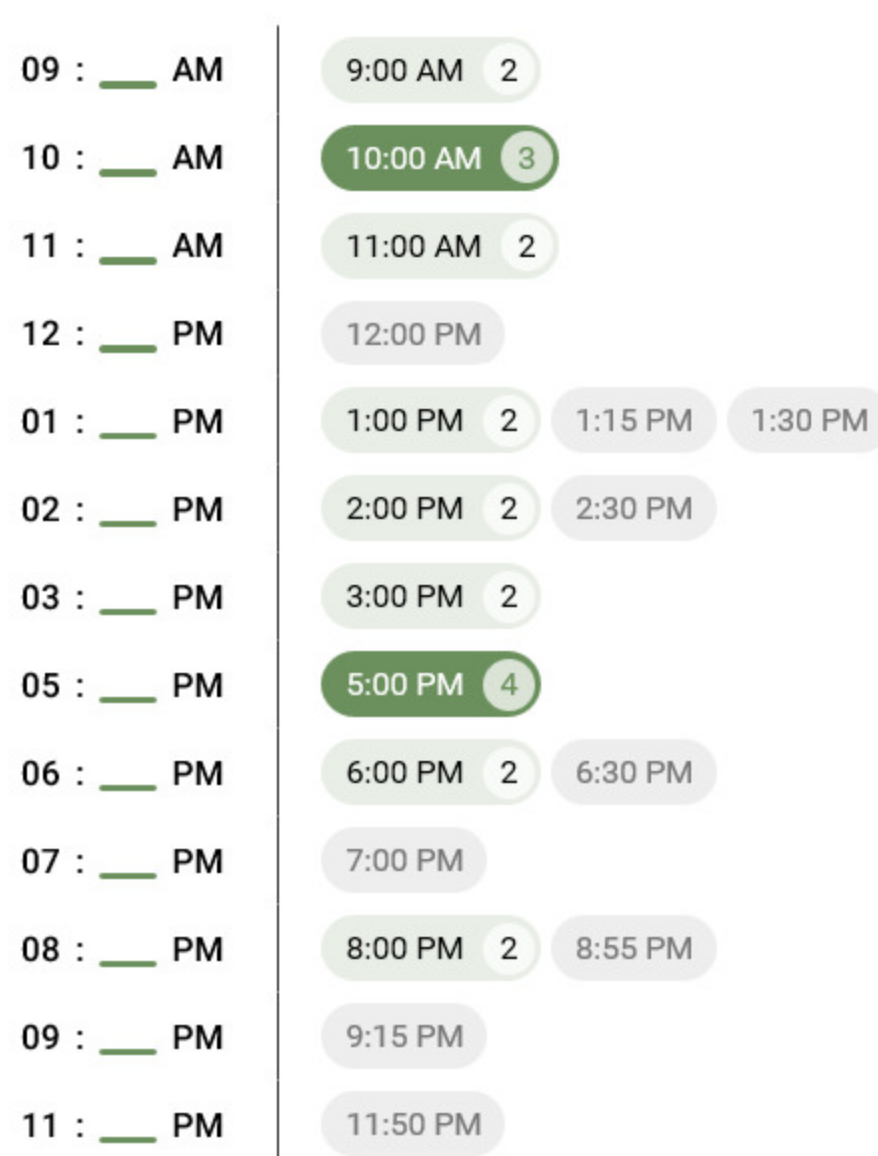

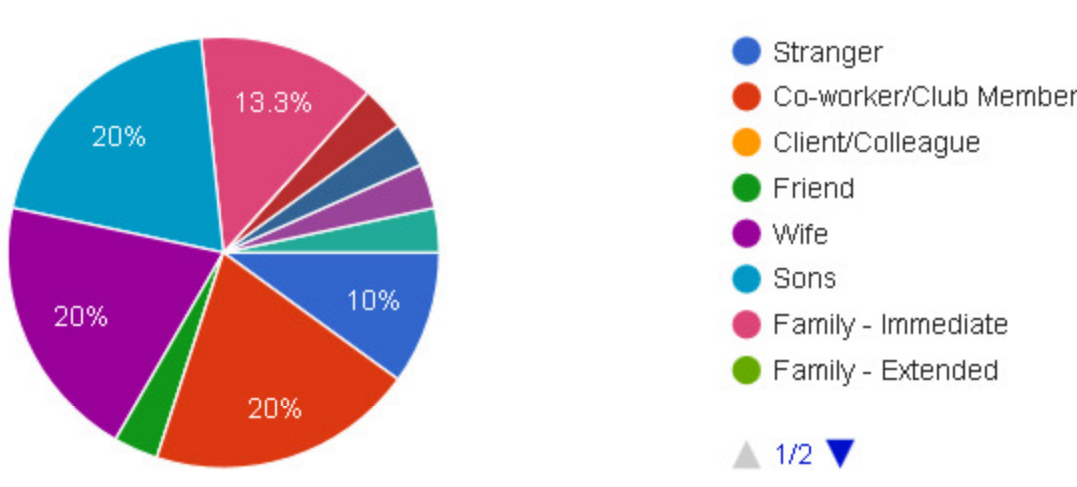

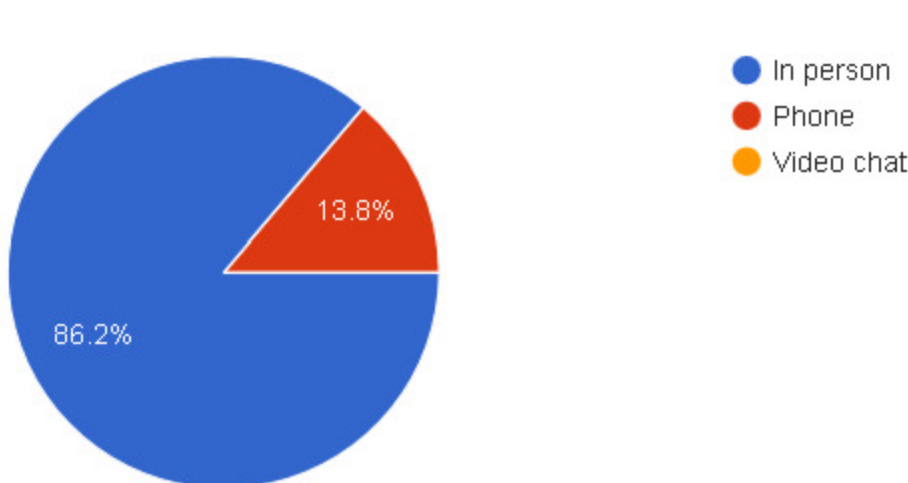
Who did you speak to?

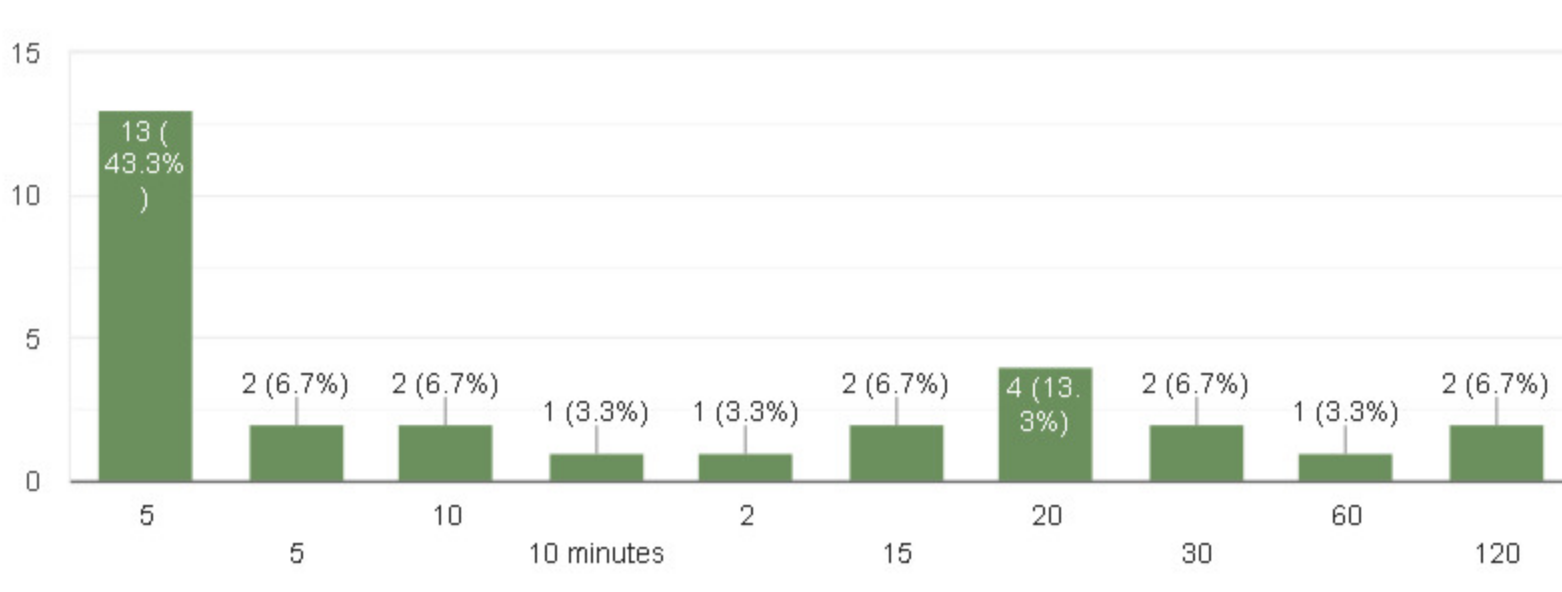

Membership benefits, schedule and fees at our local pool

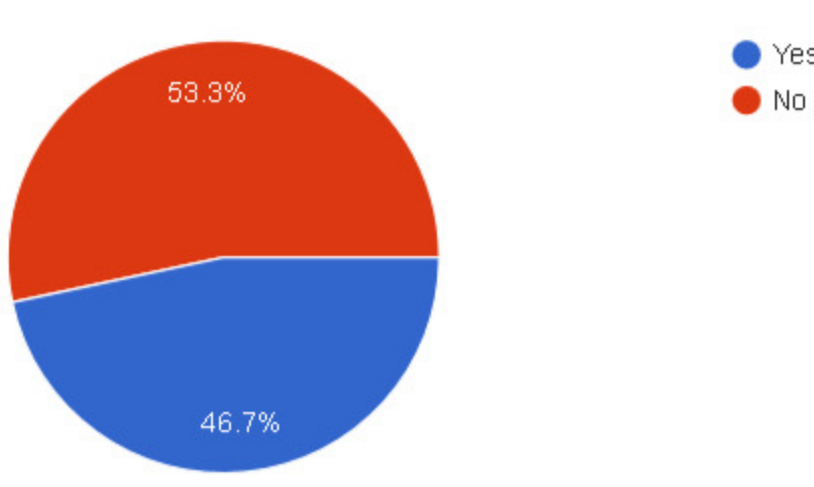
Why? What initiated the conversation?

Being social, enjoying the holiday weekend and the extra day of rest

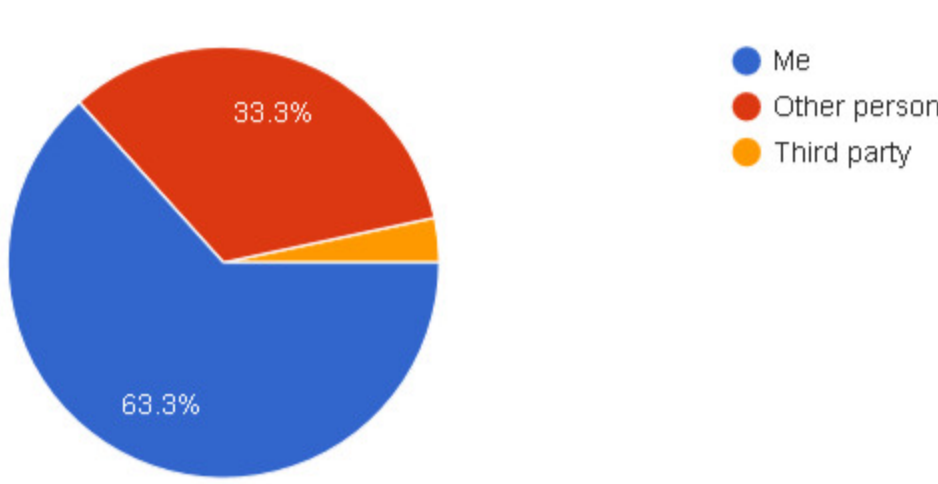
Did the exchange cause an action, consequence, or condition?

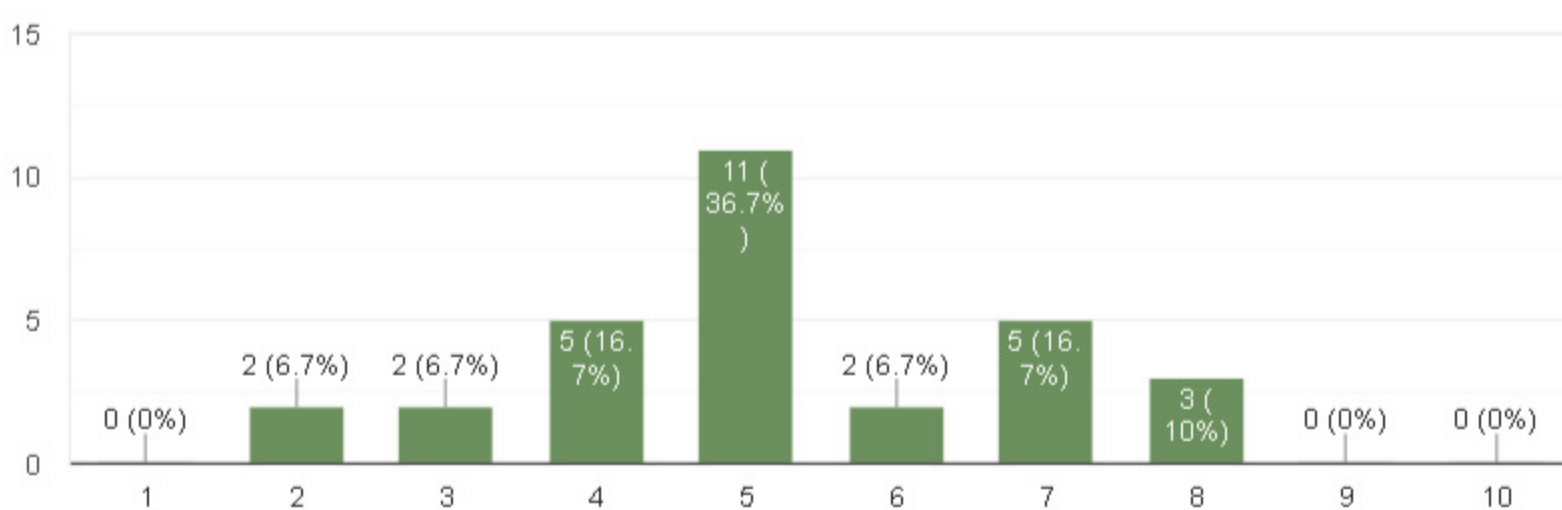
Who initiated the conversation?
